What is PEMM?



Political Economy Mapping Methodology - analytical tool

- **Assess threats and opportunities to countries presented by the low carbon transition**
- Condensing complex socioeconomic data into a relatively simple form
 - visualise and assess **in-country real economy trade-offs**
 - **Comparative risks and opportunities across countries**
- **Used already: UNFCCC, UK and Colombian Governments to Avaaz and Greenpeace.**
- **Over 25 countries in detail since 2010**

Capacity building “tool”



Aim:

- Guide **governments** on the political economy choices
- Building capacity of the **EU Institutions, European decision makers**
- ‘Skilling up’ **NGOs/advocacy groups**

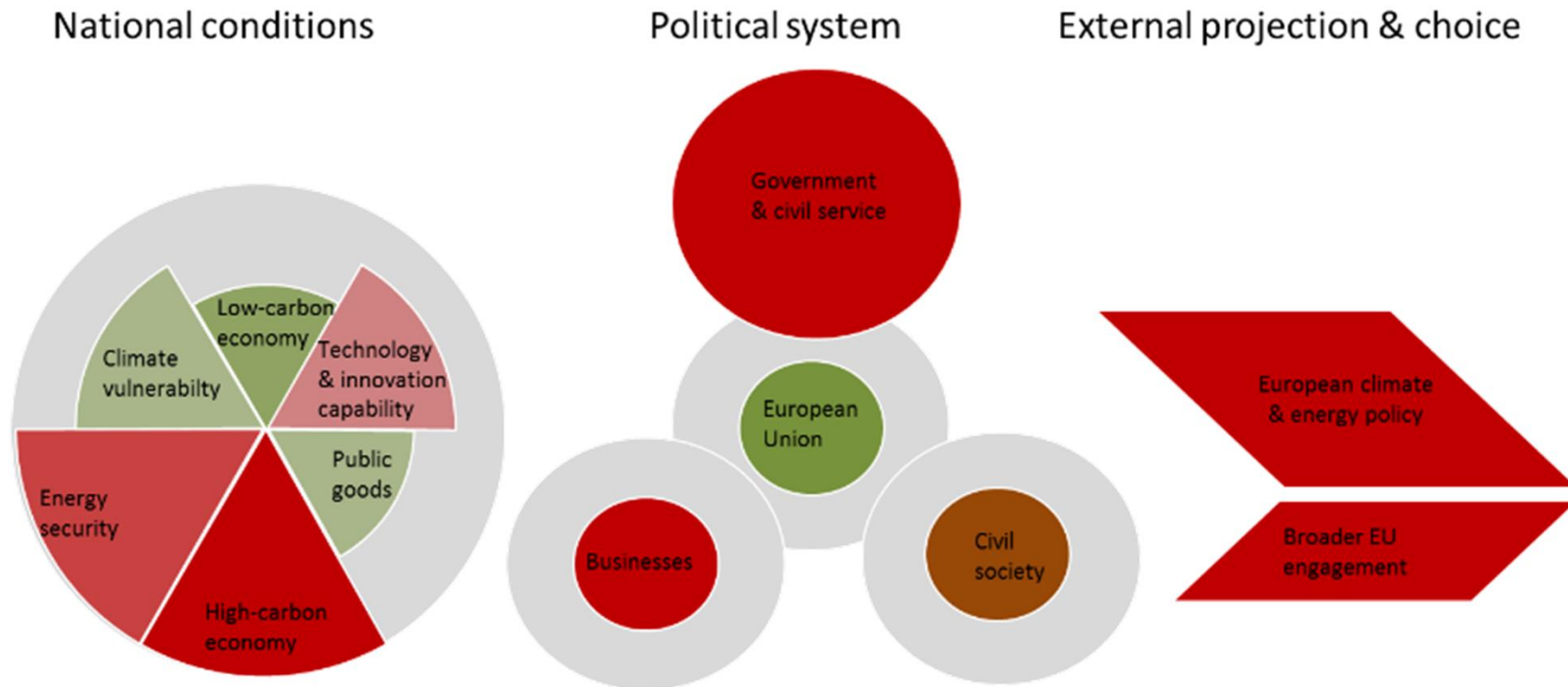
Actions:

- Desk research
- Stakeholder forums (reality check)
 - Getting to know the main actors
 - Building informal network
 - In country cross sectoral information sharing

Why PEMM matters?



- Looking at the broader picture
- Gives better keys to the politics of energy/climate
- Reaching out to a broader audience than the sectoral assessments
- Comprehensive overview
- Easier to digest and more interesting for political minds, high level decision makers
- Comparative positioning across countries

What have we learned?

- Every V4 country/government has its historic “favourites”
- Soviet type policy making – supply side
- Low carbon is not priority v. threatens the status quo
- EE - rhetoric support is given
- EU funding problems
